







Health Checks

but this won't last for long.




We will look at your eyes with a

Breast Checks 47 -73 years



A breast check looks for cancer.

Only for **women**




The test is an X-ray

The X-ray machine is uncomfortable or painful for some women.




It is only for a few seconds.



You will be sent a letter with the results of your x-rays. You may need another test at the hospital.

Bowel checks for 60-74 years old



A bowel test looks for cancer.

It is for **men and women.**




You will be sent a test which you can do at home.



The test looks for blood in your poo.



The test is posted to the nurse.




This will decide if you need another test at the hospital



Artery check for 65 years or older



An artery check is a way of looking for a swelling in an artery in your tummy.



It is for **men**



The test is an ultrasound and doesn't hurt.

The nurse will tell you your result straight away.

You may need another test at the hospital.
